

Case Study



Chestnut Lodge

Chestnut Lodge was an old, detached house that just leaked heat, the new owners Bill and Anne Hawthorne, who are the directors of Green Deal Assessments Kent have decided to turn this home into an ECO house for the future while retaining its original style and character.

The Coloured Render Co Ltd accessed ECO funding for the project of external wall insulation to the property to the level of full funding.



The top section of the property was just tile hung, we removed the tiles that could not be saved due to years of ill repair, we fixed waterproof ply and cement calcium board before insulating the whole house with 90mm thick jubisol graphite insulation.

Next we rehung new Kent peg tiles to the top section of the property before rendering the bottom section in Jub silicone render system.

Due to the stringent nature of Eco and Green Deal works every step of the process has to be recorded in order to give the 25 year guarantee required under Eco and Green Deal.



The Green deal assessment was carried out by Green Deal Assessments Kent and the funding was secured by the Coloured Render Co Ltd via one of our funders.
